Details	Faith will introduce herself and her work and give a brief history of Cammell Lairds. (Ideally the class will have visited the Made of Iron exhibition at the Williamson Art Gallery, May – Sept 2019). The class will be split into three groups, each group will create their own 'iron ship' using recycled cardboard. Participants will then recreate the textures and patina of the iron surface through dyeing and ripping cardboard. The iron ship sculptures will also include a scaffolding structure typically used in the shipbuilding process.
