

# Artist Led Workshops

<b>Workshop</b>	Street Art
<b>Details</b>	<p>Emily will start by giving the students examples of street art for them to be inspired by at the beginning of the lesson, as well as examples of her own work. We will put the introductions into practice and use spray paint, acrylic paints, collage, and drawing materials to explore a visual world beyond the usual design principles and concerns of composition. We'll begin with an underlying structure/theme, then we'll move to a broader kind of visual improvisation where you get to create-as-you-go.</p> <p>Compositionally we will explore factors all working together at once - color, line, shape, contrast, focal area, movement, etc. We will look at opposites; saturated/neutral, dark/light, busy/quiet, textured/flat, bright/dull etc. The arrangement of these elements and their relationship to one another, how to put these onto paper together without offending the eyes. We will incorporate some text and then get them to copy some other artists styles.</p> <p>Finally, the students will be given the freedom to create their own piece of street art style work, or to work in a small group.</p>
<b>Age Range</b>	Year 7-11
<b>Materials</b>	<p><b>Provided by artist:</b> Face masks, spray paint, acrylic paint, canvases, etc.</p> <p><b>Provided by school:</b> TBC – schools can provide some of above and bring down materials costs.</p>
